

FSRC AMBASSADOR PROGRAM 2006

OBJECTIVE

To create an extensive base of active respiratory professionals, one within each Hospital/Facility to function as a liaison to the FSRC. To educate each Ambassador about the Bylaws and Policies & Procedures of the FSRC and the AARC. To improve communications with the FSRC. To establish a knowledgeable pool from which future Chapter Directors and Officers may be elected.

STRUCTURE

Under the direction of Respiratory Management, each hospital and educational facility will designate an "Ambassador" to function as a communicator between their facility and the FSRC.

Ambassadors will work in conjunction with their respective Chapter Director, meeting to establish plans to expand Chapter membership and involvement in promotion of the FSRC. Chapter Directors will establish a data base of e-mail addresses for their Ambassadors, and provide the list to the Executive Office. Ambassadors will routinely receive information from the Executive Office via e-mail and other methods to disperse to his/her constituents. They will also address FSRC inquiries, problems, and answer questions from coworkers at their facility, and act as liaison to the FSRC.

The total group should be in excess of 200 Ambassadors.

President Elect and Immediate Past President will maintain regular communication with Chapter Directors to evaluate progress and future direction of the program.
